### Music fundraiser – Mark Bishop

Mark Bishop presented a proposal to host the “Trills and Frills” music festival at Clayton Middle School. Schools from the valley would come to adjudicated and the music department would be paid up to \$6.00 per student who attends. The goal would be to raise about \$23,000 to be used to fund the Lagoon festival for Clayton band and orchestra students, repair and maintain instruments, and to replace aging instruments.
